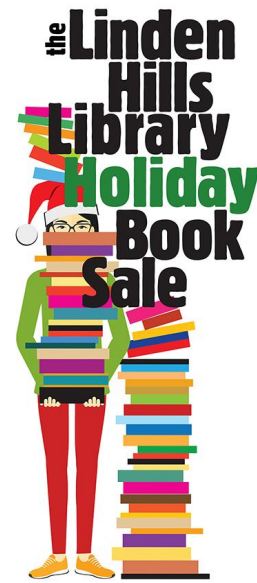
Reindeer Day at Linden Hills Library

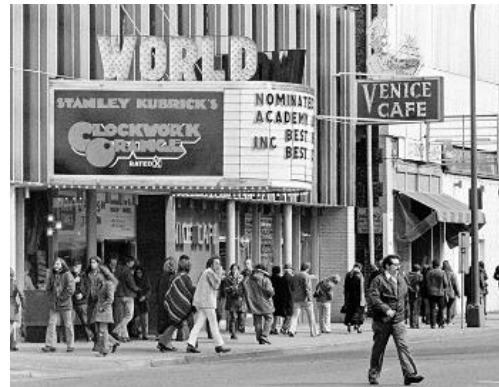
